6 x 304 Stainless Steel Eyelets

2 x Grooved 304 Stainless Steel Large Hole  
Spacer Beads

1 x 3mm 304 Stainless Steel Glue in Magnet

25cm 3mm Braided Leather

## Tools & Other Required Items

Beading Needle - Size 10 or 12

Thread - Fireline 6lb / S-Lon Fire 4lb / Miyuki  
or KO

Scissors

Thread Burner

Awl

Gorilla Super Glue Gel (or another brand of  
Super Glue Gel)







Design and bead count above are for all three of the beaded beads shown in the photo on page 1.

You will need to adjust the length of the leather cut based on your wrist size, we advise having at least one completed bead on the leather when testing the length.

## Stitches Used

**Peyote** - an off-loom beading technique, it can be worked with either an even or odd number of beads per row.

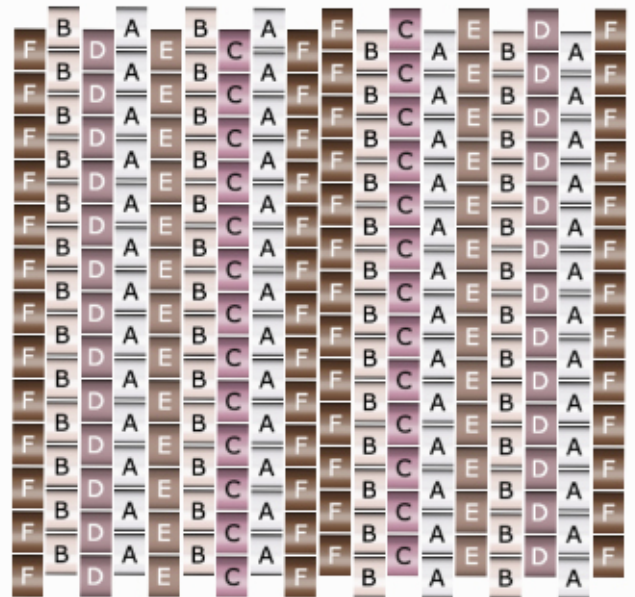

## Instructions - Peyote Tube Bead - Finishing Touches

This video demonstrates how to glue the eyelets into each end of the peyote tube.

For this step you will need a gel based super glue to secure the eyelets in place. Lynda has used a beading awl to assist when adding glue to the eyelet and setting the tube into place on the eyelet.

To make the bracelet, cut the end of the leather on a slight angle and glue into the the smaller of the magnet holes. Slide on one of the peyote tube beads and test the length of the leather needed for the desired fit. Once the leather has been cut to the desired length, glue it into the larger magnet hole.

Once the glue has dried, you can slide on the peyote tube beads or the stainless steel beads to finish off the bracelet.
